**Attendance Policy**

Students will be allowed three (3) absences. Students missing more than six (6) hours of class or more than the equivalent of three (3) absences will be dropped from that class without refund of tuition.

Tardiness of more than 15 minutes will be considered as one absence.

If a student displays disruptive behavior, he/she will be sent home for the day. This absence will count toward their total absences.
