GARDENS & GROUNDS

With 6 beautiful acres of land, maintenance is needed year-round to keep our property warm and welcoming to members and guests. The needs generally include: planting, weeding, raking, cleaning up, spreading mulch, sweeping, etc.

CLUBHOUSE CLEANING

Our spacious, 110-year-old+, Clubhouse has continual need for upkeep and cleaning. Any help offered – no matter the amount – is much appreciated by our members, especially those living with cancer whose immune systems less able to defend against germs. Groups help by dusting, window washing, sanitizing surfaces, vacuuming and mopping, polishing furniture, etc.

SUPPER TOGETHER

Offering free home-cooked meals Monday-Thursday year-round is a significant way that Gilda's Club supports our members. Your group can help by working a Meal Assist shift in our kitchen (3:30-7:00PM, including prep, serving and clean-up); preparing elements of the meal from our kitchen (between 9:30-1:30AM) or from off-site; donating groceries, gift cards, funds, etc. to be used for the Supper Together program.
